INTRODUCTION TO AGILITY OBSTACLES - This eight-week course is designed to introduce the dog to most of the individual AKC/UKC obstacles with safety, fun and competitive excellence in mind. Most work is on-lead however for you to successfully complete the class and make the most of this opportunity, it is important that you have some degree of off-leash control. The training committee highly recommends the completion of an obedience class prior to participating in this class. Each dog should know how to sit, down, stay and come. Dogs must be at least six months of age to participate in this class.

Spring Session: Wednesdays Beginning April 18, 2007 at 6:30 P.M. to 7:45 P.M.

Summer Session: Wednesdays Beginning July 18, 2007 at 6:30 P.M. to 7:45 P.M.

AGILITY OBSTACLES II - This eight-week course focuses on improving the dog and handler skills that were introduced in the **Introductory** class. Students will continue to gain experience on the equipment learned in the Introductory class and will be introduced to additional equipment. Students will also begin to learn sequencing of obstacles. Dogs are expected to show more off-leash control in this class. To enroll in this class, your dog must have successfully completed our **Introductory to Agility Obstacles** class or complete a prescreening session with agility instructors prior to being admitted into this class.

Spring Session: Thursdays Beginning April 19, 2007 at 6:30 P.M. to 7:45 P.M.

Summer Session: Thursdays Beginning July 19, 2007 at 6:30 P.M. to 7:45 P.M.

PUPPY AGILITY CLASS – This eight week class focuses on having fun with your new puppy as you introduce them to the wonderful world of agility

Spring Session: Thursdays Beginning April 19, 2007 at 6:30 P.M. to 7:45 P.M.

ADVANCED HANDLING CLASS – This eight week class focuses on different handling techniques. This is an advanced class and requires the dogs be proficient on all obstacles including a set of weave poles (straight up) and must be under verbal control.

Spring Session: Wednesdays Beginning April 18, 2007 at 6:30 P.M. to 7:45 P.M.

Summer Session: Wednesdays Beginning July 18, 2007 at 6:30 P.M. to 7:45 P.M.

Our Instructors at Capital City Canine Club are currently competing in AKC and UKC Agility and or Obedience and have earned agility and obedience titles on their own dogs. These instructors have volunteered their time to show you the exciting world of agility.

Training methods: Our agility classes are structured using positive motivational techniques.

No choke chains, pinch collars or electronic/training collars are allowed in class.

Refund Policy: If you decide to withdraw from class for any reason, you will receive a refund for all unused classes if we can fill your spot with someone on the waiting list. This is only possible if you withdraw no later than one day after the first class session. After this date, it will be too late to fill your spot with someone else. In addition, because our classes always fill to their limits; we cannot credit unused classes to a later date.

Capital City Canine Club reserves the right to reassign or remove a student from class if the Training Committee believes the dog and handler would benefit from more obedience work.

Rain night/extreme heat make up: Because classes are held outside at Whitehill's Memorial Park, class may be cancelled due to rain or extreme heat. Classes will be made up at the end of the session but will not exceed June 21st for the Spring session or September 20th for the Summer session.

Open floor time is available following each night of class for those dogs and handlers that are already familiar with the equipment. Contact Melanie for more information.
